On Wednesday, June 16th, twenty one St. Vital Curling Club past presidents gathered at Falcon Lake for their annual golf tournament and barbeque.

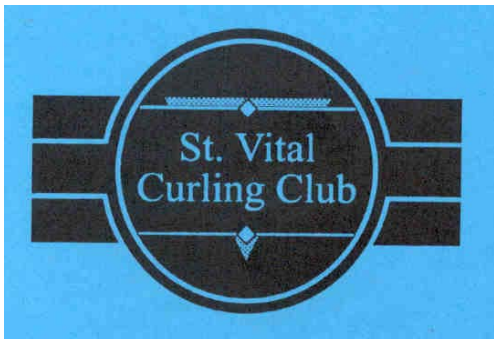
Winner of the trophy and jacket was Brian Davies, pictured to the right!
