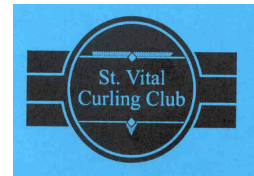

MEN'S LEAGUES MISCELLANEOUS

For all Men's League teams, please mark the game results directly on the draw charts for each respective night.

For any games that are not played at the scheduled time, please note that the teams have until the end of the round to complete these games. If a make-up game is not played, the team that originally defaulted the game will incur the loss.

Of interest to new teams to the club, each round winner in a group receives \$20 in bar bucks from the club. The 1st round is used for seeding, but the last 3 rounds of the year allow the group winners to qualify for year-end playoffs. Please note that in some cases, even if your team did not win a round, your team may still qualify for playoffs.

ATTENDANCE DRAW

All members of the Men's curling leagues are eligible for an attendance draw. The "CAN" as it is called, is in the lounge (BAR). A member's number is drawn after curling Monday through Thursday. The member drawn will receive 100% of the proceeds IF he/she is signed in. To be eligible, put 25¢ in the CAN and sign your name in the book.
